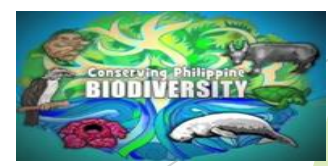

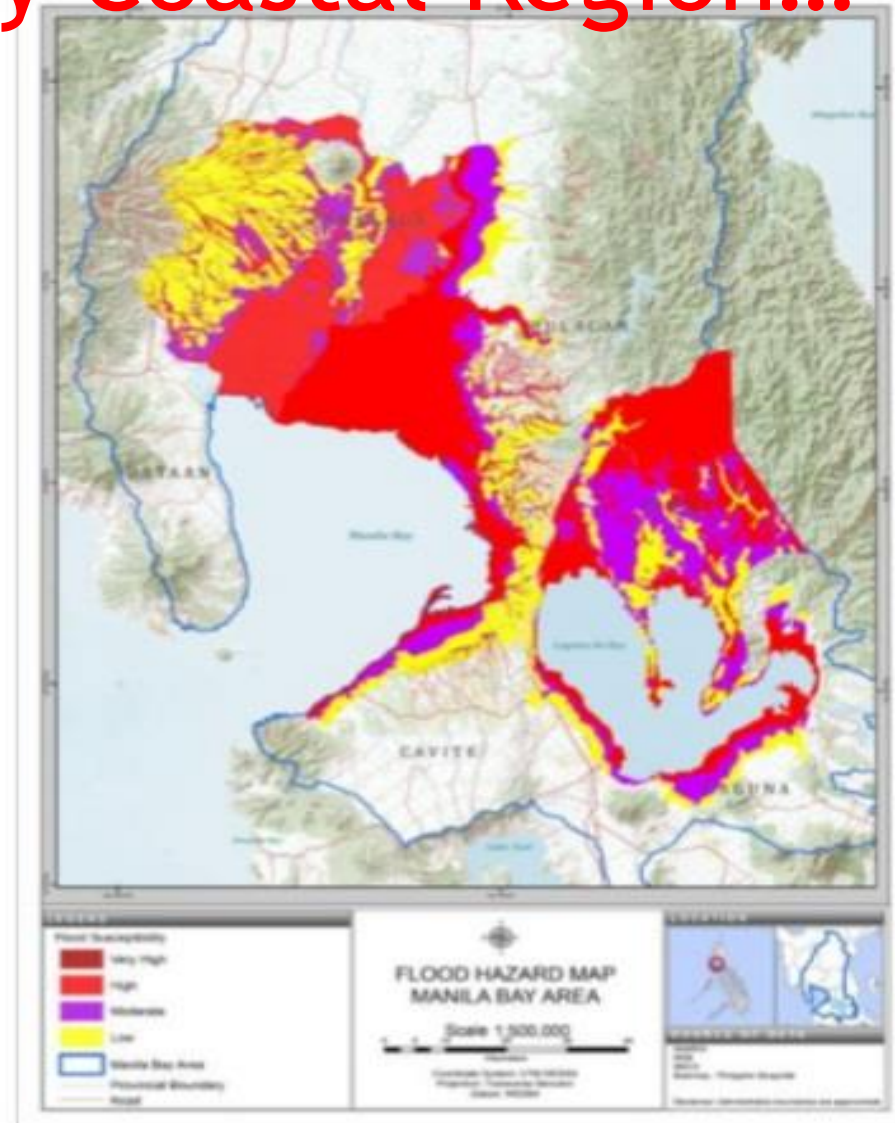

# Manila Bay Coastal Region...

**Climate change vulnerability for many communities in this coastal region has to do with flooding due to deforestation of the uplands, leading to erosion & siltation and clogging of rivers by solid wastes entering into river ways.**
